January 9, 2008 Veterinary Medical Licensing Board Meeting Minutes

Dr. David Koncal, President of the Ohio Veterinary Medical Licensing Board called the January 9, 2008 meeting to order at 08:30 a.m. in the Board Room at 77 S. High Street, 31st Floor, Columbus, Ohio.

Theresa Stir, Executive Director, reported that the directives from the last board Directives meeting had been completed.

HB 104

Ms. Stir provided the Board members with an update on HB 104, the Criminal Background Check bill. The bill was signed by the Governor and will become law 90 days after signature. The Board must now amend the rules to reflect the legislative changes. The Board was presented with proposed rule changes for Rule 4741-1-01 and 4741-1-04. Dr. Gitz moved to approve and file proposed rules 4741-1-01 and 4741-1-04 OAC as presented. Dr. Burt seconded the motion. Ms. Stir informed the Board that the Governor's office has not yet named a Board appt successor for Dr. Burt's seat on the Board.

Ms. Stir provided the Board with an update on the current budget.

Budget Guidelines

.Copies of the State of Ohio Medical Board Disciplinary Guidelines were Disciplinary provided. The Board directed Ms. Stir to prepare a document of previous disciplinary actions taken by the Ohio Veterinary Medical Licensing Board as a starting point for developing our own Guidelines.

A discussion was held regarding Ohio accepting RACE approved continuing RACE education. Concern was expressed regarding differentiating between scientific and nonscientific continuing education. The Board directed Ms. Stir to contact the AAVSB office for guidelines.

Ms. Stir sought guidance from the Board regarding a question related to rabies Rabies vaccine clinic and was an examination required prior to administering the rabies vaccine. After much discussion, the Board determined that there is no requirement in law or rules for an examination prior to the rabies vaccine, however according to Rule 4741-1-22 OAC, the veterinarian must maintain the record for three years. The Board directed Ms. Stir to provide the feedback to the questioning veterinarian and refer to the applicable rule.
