- G. **Impact of enacted legislation-** Ms. Stir provided a summary of SB 255 which was signed by Governor Kasich in December, 2018. The first section involved the sunset review of the occupational licensing boards. The second section permits an individual who has been convicted of any criminal offense to request, at any time, that a licensing ‘authority determine whether the individual’s criminal conviction disqualifies the individual from obtaining a license issued by the licensing authority. The Board directed Ms. Stir to draft a “pre-determination” form for review by the Board at the April meeting. The Board members determined that the list of offenses specified in ORC 4741.22(E) would suffice as the list required to be posted on the web site in accordance with the new law.
