1. Call to Order:

After opening the meeting with the reading of the Board mission statement, Dr. O'Connor, Past President and member of the Ohio Veterinary Medical Licensing Board called the May 11, 2022 meeting to order at 08:32 a.m.

4. Meeting Minutes: Ms. Pohler moved to approve the April 13, 2022 board minutes as written. Dr. Kolb seconded the motion. The motion passed by the following roll call vote: Ms. Pohler – aye, Dr. Kolb – aye, Dr. Walkenhorst – aye, Ms. Jones – aye, Dr. O'Connor – aye.

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10. Executive Director Report:

- A. <u>Directives</u> Ms. Stir reported that the April meeting Directives have been completed.
- B. Student Loan There were two applications submitted for the Veterinary Student Loan Repayment Loan based on resource shortage areas and public health services. There is approximately \$45,790 in the Loan Fund, however, the Board only has \$30,000 spending authority. The Board authorized each applicant to receive \$10,000 for a one year commitment with the ability to reapply next year for another possible loan award. \$10,000 each was awarded to Dr. Chelsea Naylor from Findlay, Ohio and Dr. Hannah Jarvis practicing in Hillsboro, Ohio.
- C. <u>Virtual CE</u> The Board staff requested clarification on the difference in online continuing education. After much discussion, the Board members determined that "realtime" virtual continuing education is equivalent to "realtime" in person continuing education. Realtime virtual CE cannot be paused and has check points within the program to make sure the participant is in attendance.
- D. <u>Election Vice-President</u>- Since Dr. Scott Myers resigned from the position on the Board, the Vice-President position was vacant. The Board members elected Dr. Nancy O'Connor to the Vice-President position.
- E. Non-compliance with Agreement- Ms. Stir presented evidence of Dr. O'Desky-Reichel's noncompliance with the Settlement Agreement. Per the terms of the agreement, Dr. O'Desky-Reichel's license to practice will be automatically suspended until compliance with the terms of the Agreement. Dr. Kolb moved to automatically suspend Dr. O'Desky-Reichel's license to practice veterinary medicine until she comes into compliance with the Agreement. Dr. Walkenhorst seconded the motion. The motion passed with the following votes: Ms. Pohler -aye, Dr. Kolb aye, Dr. Walkenhorst aye, Ms. Jones aye, and Dr. O'Connor aye.
- F. <u>June board meeting</u> Due to a conflict with an AAVSB board meeting, the OVMLB needed to reschedule the June Board meeting originally scheduled for June 8, 2022. The rescheduled date is June 7, 2022 and will be via TEAMS.
