## MEETING MINUTES November 13, 2019

---

### **Adjudication Hearing:** Case#19-19-057 *OVMLB vs Michael Smith, DVM*

Ms. Zigler, Assistant Attorney General (AAG) presented the prehearing motion before the Board with response from Mr. John Izzo, Esq representing Dr. Michael Smith, DVM at 10:15 a.m.

**Deliberative session** – At 10:25 a.m., the Board went into deliberative session to deliberate the pre-hearing motion on File #19-19-057 regarding Michael Smith, DVM. All attendees except for the Board members and Lidia Mowad, AAG left the room.

Dr. Kidd announces that the Hearing is back on the record at 10:35 a.m. and the Hearing continued.

**Deliberative session** – At 12:20., Dr. Kidd announced the Board going into deliberative session to deliberate on File #19-19-057 regarding Michael Smith, DVM. All attendees, except for the Board members, Lidia Mowad, AAG and Cory Gee, AAG.

Dr. Kidd announces that the Hearing back in public session at 1:36 p.m.

Dr. Kidd moved in the matter of Case File #19-19-057, Michael Smith, I move that the Board issue an adjudication order finding the following:

- That, pursuant to R.C. 4741.22(A)(9), the State Veterinary Medical Licensing Board may refuse to issue a license to any applicant who is convicted of or pleads guilty to any felony;
- That Michael Smith submitted an application for licensure to practice as a veterinarian in the State of Ohio on March 31, 2019;
- That, within that application, Michael Smith admitted to surrendering his license after he pled guilty to and was convicted of ten counts of the illegal processing of drug documents;
- That res judicata did not bar the Board's determination of whether Mr. Smith is qualified for licensure;
- That Michael Smith properly requested a hearing that went to hearing today, November 13, 2019 at 10 AM, before this Board , and that Michael Smith met his burdens of proof and persuasion to show that he meets the requirements to become a licensed veterinarian in the State of Ohio; and
- That the State Veterinary Medical Licensing Board issues a license to Michael Smith after demonstrating his qualification for licensure, with a reprimand letter containing

suggestions from the Board that Mr. Smith attend OPHP counseling for five years and operate his practice under direct supervision by a licensed veterinarian. Dr. Verbsky seconded the motion.
