Dr. Gitz moved to withdraw Rule 4741-1-14 OAC from the original rule filing. 4741-1-14 OAC Dr. Burt seconded the motion. The motion passed by a unanimous roll call vote. Ms. Stir reminded members that the Rule will be on the Agenda in October for proposed changes. Ms. Stir asked Dr. Eaton if OVMA could have their recommendations to the Board members by the October 10th meeting.

Dr. Gitz moved to withdraw Rule 4741-1-06 OAC from the original rule filing 4741-1-06 OAC and refile as a "No Change" rule. Dr. Redman seconded the motion. The motion passed by a unanimous roll call vote.

OVMA raised concerns in their public hearing testimony regarding Rule 4741-1-21 OAC in which a veterinarian who leaves a practice may not have access to the 4741-1-21 OAC treatment records the way the rule is written currently. The Board took their recommendations under advisement. Dr. Gitz moved to revise the rule filing for Rule 4741-1-21 OAC by striking the term "subsequent" to proposed Rule 4741-1-21(D) OAC. Dr. Redman seconded the motion. The motion passed by a unanimous roll call vote.

OVMA also raised issues with Rule 4741-2-03 OAC regarding limited licensure. The Board reviewed the Section 4741.13 of the Revised Code which states that the Board "may issue" a limited license. The Board also reviewed Section 4741.01 ORC Proposed which defines the practice of veterinary medicine. The Board believes at this time that 4741-2-03 proposed Rule 4741-2-03 sufficiently addresses the concerns raised regarding researchers. The Board recognized that since the rule is new, it will need to be reviewed along with other new rules within the first year of implementation to determine effectiveness and the need for further revisions.
