Ms. Hissom stated that Tri-C had sent in a question for the Board about the new practice act provisions regarding dentistry. The Board directed that RVT's are not to make any incisions even to excise teeth. Ms. Hissom updated the Board on implementation of the new provisions of the Practice Act. The licensure forms will be available at the board's website at the end of September or beginning of October. Officially, payment for the new license types can't be deposited or accepted until after the law is in effect. Ms. Hissom stated she had been contacted by Charlotte Ronan about having the board review and support a resolution to be presented at the conference regarding security issues and the NBVME. There have been security breaches without effective communication making it difficult for states to know how to approach approving candidates or issuing licenses.
